



NEWS RELEASE – MN GOP “Candidate-Journalist,” current Gov. candidate, calls on Gov. Pawlenty & other candidates to do videotaped discussions on recent constitutional impeachment theory, and to join in calling for Pres. Trump’s impeachment or resignation

“Candidate-Journalist” and current candidate for the GOP endorsement and nomination for Governor Bob “Again” Carney Jr. (“bobagain”) today called on former Governor Tim Pawlenty, and other candidates, to do “individual half hour videotaped discussions on my recent constitutional impeachment theory, and to join my call for President Trump’s immediate impeachment



or resignation.” If Pawlenty, and/or another Republican who either becomes endorsed, or emerges as a major prospect in a contested GOP primary, joins in the call, bobagain will withdraw as a candidate and will support such GOP candidates. U. of M. Law Professor Richard Painter is also considering a Senate candidacy for Sen. Tina Smith’s seat -- possibly as a Republican or an Independent. “At Rochester I said there will be a Republican on the GOP primary ballot this year calling for the resignation or impeachment of President Trump. I’d withdraw if someone else will take on this challenge. But some Minnesota Republican MUST stand up to Trump... I will contest the primary if no one else does,” bobagain said.

So far this year bobagain has called on President Trump to resign or be impeached at two candidate forums, a [January GOP-only forum at Cannon Falls](#) with all major Republican candidates, and a [February non-partisan forum in Rochester MN](#) with all four major DFLers. At the Rochester forum, and also at a March 9th non-partisan forum in Minneapolis, bobagain also asked major DFL candidates, including Tim Walz (D-MN,) to participate in a videotaped discussion. Rep. Walz told bobagain his campaign would be in touch.

Pawlenty needs to get in touch with his “Inner Trump Truth”

Today President Trump appears to be riding high with Republicans – both nationally and in Minnesota. However, things were not always so. Immediately after the October 2016 “Access Hollywood” tape emerged, [the Associated Press reported October 8, 2016](#) that former Governor Tim Pawlenty had issued a statement saying: “Although I’d hoped he could have risen to the occasion, it’s clear Trump is unwilling or unable to demonstrate even the most basic level of discipline, character and judgment necessary to lead our great nation... He is unsound, uninformed, unhinged and unfit to be President of the United States, and I am withdrawing my support of him.”

“Former Gov. Pawlenty was right in 2016 to withdraw his support of then-candidate Trump. Today we have an urgent need for what is at heart a commitment to unity, reason, education, and discussion: centered on re-examining our Constitutional provisions for impeachment and removal. Part of my contribution to this is a new book – [BREAK GLASS IMPEACH TRUMP](#) – that demonstrates we have misunderstood the full extent of the power *and duty* of Congress to remove from office a person as manifestly unqualified as President Trump. My book demonstrates Congress has the power to simply tell our first *Celebrity Apprentice President*: ‘**You’re fired.**’ *America needs to do this.* Because he is now obviously running for Governor, I’m calling on former Governor Pawlenty to sit down with me for a half hour videotaped session – in the first fifteen minutes I’ll explain my constitutional theory and how it works – in the second half hour we’ll discuss his reaction, and his conclusion as to what Congress should do,” bobagain said.

“America’s choice today is NOT between a President Trump or a President Clinton. Our choice is between President Trump – who is manifestly unfit and unqualified, and a President Pence who is fully fit, qualified and safe. As Republicans more carefully consider both this fact, and the impeachment theory I’m advancing, I think President Trump’s support is likely to wilt in the glare of his disgusting personal behavior and standards, among many other factors. If Governor Pawlenty is willing to join me in my call for President Trump’s immediate impeachment or resignation, I will withdraw as a candidate for Governor,” bobagain concluded.

“As noted, I’m issuing the same meeting/discussion call to other GOP candidates, and to all the major DFL candidates,” bobagain said, (but without a commitment to endorse DFFers based only on this issue,) and added: “this should *not* be a partisan issue. We need to work together to begin the Pence Administration by Constitutional means ASAP.”
