



MN GOP Governor and CD 1 Special Election candidate bobagain will campaign and speak Saturday at Olmsted County GOP Convention; his upcoming book (title not yet disclosed) eyes Trump as an Insurrectionist; lays out a book length “how-to” plan to stop him in

Minneapolis, MN, 3/24/22 – Minnesota Republican “Candidate-Journalist” Bob “Again” Carney Jr. (“bobagain”) – who is running for both Governor and 1st District Congress in the May special election primary -- will speak and campaign at the Olmstead County Republican Convention on Saturday, March 26th. The Convention begins at 10 AM at Byron Middle School, 601 4th Street Northwest, Byron Minnesota. Because speakers are interspersed throughout the Convention, sometimes during lulls, it’s uncertain when bobagain will speak.

The special election is to complete the remainder of the term of the late Congressman Jim Hagedorn, who passed on last month. The 1st CD Republican Party will not endorse a candidate for the special election, according to a reliable source. However, the party is expected to endorse a candidate for the 2022 regular general election primary, which will be held August 9th, the same day as the special general election for in CD 1. If he wins the special primary, bobagain expects to be on the ballot on August 9th for both the special general election and the State GOP primary for Governor. However, in any case bobagain does not plan to seek the 1st CD seat for the upcoming full term. “I’m looking at this as something more like a situation where a long-term substitute is needed to complete a school year,” bobagain said – suggesting this would be a kind of extension of his current work as a short-term substitute teacher in Minnesota public schools.

The Congressional special election comes at a time when former President Trump’s 2016 election is coming more into focus as clearly a part of the agenda that Russian President Vladimir Putin was pursuing when Russia interfered in the 2016 U.S. Presidential election. In his soon-to-be released book bobagain takes a closer look at the Russian interference, and concludes that based on a “but-for” test often used in law the 2016 election appears to have been nothing short of a successful Russian attempt at “regime change” in America. The book also presents a plan for Congress to mandate a Supreme Court original jurisdiction criminal trial, without a jury, to determine if Trump violated a U.S. Statute against inciting or setting on foot an insurrection. “The right to a jury explicitly does not apply for ‘*Cases of Impeachment*, and while acquitted in the Senate’s non-criminal trial venue, Trump was impeached by the House for the January 6th alleged insurrection. Therefore, a separate Judicial criminal trial of Trump should properly be classified as a ‘*Case of Impeachment*’ according to the specific Article III language of the Constitution,” bobagain asserted.

Trump’s role in the Republican party is becoming a dominating issue for bobagain in both of his campaigns. “I think this is unfortunate because I have some great ideas and policy initiatives to offer. But we need to deal with the now obvious reality that Russia, Putin and Trump are inextricably bound together,” bobagain concluded.

For the remainder of the special primary campaign bobagain's candidate news releases will be conjoining his campaigns for Governor and Congress.
