



MN GOP Gov & CD 1 Special Election candidate bobagain calls for “a Criminal original jurisdiction trial in the Supreme Court of Donald Trump for insurrection” at Olmsted County GOP Convention; drowned out by loud booing; talks with many Delegates afterwards

Minneapolis, MN, 3/30/22 – A two-minute speech by Minnesota Republican “Candidate-Journalist” Bob “Again” Carney Jr. (“bobagain”) to the Olmstead County Republican Convention ended abruptly Saturday when he was drowned out by boos from the 200+ Delegates after calling for: “a Criminal original jurisdiction trial in the Supreme Court of Donald Trump for insurrection.” Bobagain, who is running for both Governor and 1st District Congress in the May special election primary, is making Donald Trump his main issue for the Congressional race. “I saw the timer hold up the 15 second sign, and was moving to ‘wrap-up’ when the booing intervened,” bobagain said, and added: “I would have concluded by saying I favored a plea bargain outcome -- a guilty plea that would keep Trump off the ballot in return for no jail time -- but was unable to conclude with that important element of my plan due to the uproar.”



About 250 were seated when the Olmsted County Republican Convention met at Byron Middle School Saturday March 26th.

With 25 or more candidates or campaign representatives, each had only two minutes. [A video of the speech is here.](#)

Each campaign had a table – bobagain’s was in the hallway immediately before people enter the lunchroom. “As a result, all the delegates walked by me twice after I spoke, as they went into and out of the lunchroom. Everyone was respectful, a few apologized or expressed regret for the uproar,” bobagain said, and added: “I had quite a few interesting discussions with Delegates, and, as I expected, many were very knowledgeable about legal and Constitutional questions that have arisen since Trump was elected in 2016. Frankly, this is one big reason I remain a Republican. I don’t think either the topical substance or the quality of these chats would have occurred at a DFL Convention. There is hope.”



Bobagain’s speech was ended abruptly by a loud chorus of boos when he called for “a Criminal original jurisdiction trial in the Supreme Court of Donald Trump for insurrection.”

One of bobagain's additional speech statements stood out in many of his chats: "The fact is in 2024 we are either going to elect a Democrat President or we are going to elect a Republican who is not Donald Trump. This is reality. We need to deal with it." Bobagain commented: "a number of Delegates explicitly agreed with that statement; no one explicitly disagreed with it. And there wasn't a peep or a murmur at that point in the speech." In bobagain's view, this is a crucial foundational view among Republicans... and one that will support a campaign to move beyond Trump.

The special election is to complete the remainder of the term of the late Congressman Jim Hagedorn, who passed on last month. The 1st CD Republican Party will not endorse a candidate for the special election, according to a reliable source.

The Congressional special election comes at a time when former President Trump's 2016 election is coming more into focus as clearly a part of the agenda that Putin and Russia were pursuing when Russia interfered in the 2016 U.S. Presidential election. Trump was effectively subsumed. In his soon-to-be released book We Must Stop Trump, bobagain takes a closer look at the Russian interference, and concludes that based on a "but-for" test often used in law the 2016 election appears to have been nothing short of a successful Russian attempt at "regime change" in America.
